Scammers often use scare tactics to get us to react emotionally – like claiming they have detected fraud on your account.

If you receive a text claiming to be from Mountain Credit Union suggesting you should click a link to address a fraudulent charge, please use caution before giving any personal information via text messaging.

What You Should Do?

- Be cautious ask yourself, "Would Mountain Credit Union really text me?"
- If you do get a text (or email / phone call) claiming to be from your us, do not interact.
- Call us directly at (828)564-1781 to ensure we are actually trying to reach you.
- If you, like so many others are using our MCU Mobile app for added security, protect your accounts by using unique passwords and enabling two-factor authentication.
